The Antoinette Berkel Memorial Scholarship is a \$5,000 renewable tuition assistance scholarship for a student accepted and enrolled at the University of Saint Mary. This scholarship is based on academic performance, financial need, and demonstrated community involvement. Preference will be given to students who have attended Catholic high schools.

This scholarship was established in 2006 by Charles J. Berkel in memory of his wife Antoinette "Toni" Berkel to encourage and support young people desiring a Catholic education.

Selection Committee

A selection committee comprised of and including the University President and another representative of the University of Saint Mary will determine the scholarship recipient.

Application Deadline

The application deadline is May 1. **All scholarship materials must be complete—incomplete forms will not be accepted.** Scholarship materials should be sent to the University of Saint Mary, Admissions Office, 4100 South 4th Street, Leavenworth, Kansas 66048.

Criteria for Consideration

- 1. Academic requirements of 3.2 cumulative HS GPA and 20 Composite ACT.
- 2. Be admitted to the University of Saint Mary.
- 3. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- 4. Complete the attached scholarship application.
- 5. Include contact information for two non-related references.
